## Press Release for Ausin High Swimming Westlake High School District Preview Sprint Meet

On Tuesday, October 8, the Austin High School Swimming and Diving teams competed in the annual Belton ISD Quad Meet. The meet was a yearly competition between Austin High and the four Belton ISD schools – Belton High, Lake Belton High, and Belton New Tech High School.

The meet was not a scored competition, meaning no points were kept for the places or team scoring. "This is a meet we've get invited to every year that is not about team scores. We are often four very different sized programs, with a wide range of swimmers," said Austin head coach Ryan Goodwyn. "It's not about team scores, but about giving all of our kids, especially our newer swimmers, a chance to compete in a meet with a lot of kids, so we can have multiple heats. It gives more kids a chance to race against a heat of other swimmers of their same speed."

Still, even though the meet was not scored, the times did count as official times. Among the Maroons 38 individual swims, 14 were new personal best times for the Maroon swimmers.

"I saw a lot of improvement among some of our new kids today," Goodwyn said. "They're taking what they learned from the first few meets and really applying it well to getting better each time. We came away with over one third of our swims as new personal bests!"

The Maroons next competition will be on October 25 at the Austin ISD Invitational at the UT Swim Center.
