Press Release for Tri-Meet with Cedar Ridge HS and Dominic Savio HS

On Friday, Nov. 15, the Austin High School swimming and diving teams competed in a tri-meet with Cedar Ridge High School and Dominic Savio at the Round Rock ISD Natatorium.

Austin High head coach explained that how the team placed depends on how the meet is scored. “A three team meet can be scored two ways,” he explained. “It can be scored as three teams with a first, second, and third place team. Or, it can be scored as three dual meets, with a score for team A vs team B, team A vs. team C, and team B vs team C.”

If scored as a three team meet, the Maroons finished in second place for both the boys and the girls. If scored as a double-dual meet, the Maroon Ladies beat Dominic Savio and lost to Cedar Ridge while the boys won against both schools.

However, Goodwyn points out that the scores were not the important part to him. “One of these teams is UIL, and the other is a TAPPS private school,” he said. “The point results of this don’t affect our season at all. What I was looking for is how our kids raced at the end of a hard week and how they used this as a chance to get up and push themselves against competitors. It’s all about getting ready for our district and regional meets in January and February. And we raced really well tonight after a hard week.”

The Maroons had 33% of their individual swims as new personal best times for the swimmers. Their next meet will be the CRHS Last Chance meet at the same pool on December 14.
